Application- Site Plan Review- SPR# 16-3 Verizon Wireless has applied to construction 180' self-supporting tower with additional 4' lightening rod and 11'6x16'platform surrounded by a chain link fence.

Following a brief discussion the board accepted the application as complete and went into the SEQRA Review.

Chairman read the SEQRA short form questions to the members for decision.

Each item read and a negative finding was determined.

Motion by Dave 2nd Floyd to accept the completed SEQRA and declare that the proposed action will not result in any significant adverse environmental impacts 4-Aye 1 Nay, (Hessney-nay) carried.

Motion by Dave to approve the site plan #16-3, 2nd Linda, carried by all.

Application Area Variance #16-11 for Height . Verizon Wireless has applied to construct and operate a wireless telecommunication facility on 2382 Hazard Road, leased property owned by Nathan Burkholder.

A height variance is needed as the 180' tower exceeds the maximum height allowed by Torrey Zoning for a Agricultural District.

Chairman recommended approval of Area Variance # 16-11 2nd Linda and carried with vote of 4 Ayes 1 Nay (Hessney-nay)
