

Town Board Minutes
August 14, 2018

The monthly meeting of the Torrey Town Board was held on Tuesday August 14, 2018 at 56 Geneva St. Dresden NY and called to order by Supervisor Flynn at 7:30PM.

Mr. Flynn led the pledge of allegiance.

Mr. Flynn presented the abstract of vouchers for review.

Motion by Mr. Martini 2nd Mr. Petersen, that the bills on the General A & B accounts in the amount of \$ 12,122.74 be paid, carried.

Motion by Mr. Martini, 2nd Mr. Petersen, that the bills on the Highway DA & DB accounts, in the amount of \$ 85,894.81 be paid, carried by all.

Mr. Flynn introduced the Solar Law Regulations Public and read a resolution to set public hearing for September 11, 2018 at 7:30PM, 2nd Mr. Martini

Flynn- Aye, Martini- Aye, Petersen- Aye, Martin- Aye and Downs- Aye- 5 Ayes 0 Nays

Mr. Downs reported on Newsletter. Estimate cost at print shop \$ 700./ Quarterly He will send out an email September and December newsletter and next postal mailing would be in April. He noted that the Town is in the 2019 budgeting process and the newsletter mailing be added in.

Brief discussion on content of next newsletter.

Mr. Downs noted that there was no action taken in the July minutes for Eileen Moreland requesting results with letters to the DEC about SPEDS permit renewal Penn Yan Wastewater Treatment Plant and Greenidge Lockwood site remediation progress.

Motion by Mr. Downs 2nd Mr. Martin to approved July meeting, carried.

Mr. Chambers reported work on plugged culvert pipe on Larzelere Rd. Repaired cross over pipe on Nutt Rd that had collapsed.

Safety Audit of shop and barn has been completed. Presented corrections needed.

Discussion on contracting with engineering services needed to complete corrections.

Gradall need to be declared surplus so it can be sold, being replaced by the 2006 Cat Excavator purchased from Town of Milo.

Visited Viking Plow to check on new truck, the truck should be delivered by October.

He presented a work place violence protection policy, he would like town to adopt, was tabled to September meeting.

Dave Granzin inquired on various speed zones from railroad to curve on Perry Point Rd.

Mr. Chambers state the reduced speed is required on curve, NYS DOT sets the speed, Town supplies the signs. Brief discussion on guiderails.

Dwight James gave the code report. 1 C of O, 1 sub division app, 2 violations Insp, 2 site visits, 6 meetings, 5 fire inspections 93 Miles.

Discussion on short term rental issues. Along the lake there may be boathouses being rented out. Who can check on these properties? The code officer has limited authority and cannot enter properties without invitation by owner or tenant.

Perry Point Water District- Ad Hoc Committee request to reopen negotiations with the Village of Dresden on the water supply contract, to discuss a few items and charges.

Mr. Downs attended a village meeting and it is the consensus that at this point, both boards should meet to discuss the contract.

Town will send an invite to the Village of Dresden for a meeting on September 5, 2018 at 7:30 in the Town meeting room. Motion by Mr. Downs 2nd Mr. Martin carried.
